### **Lists of Songs 2023**

#### **Main List**

Chorus copies and pianist's music for all these songs are in separate folders. Those folders are several file cabinets at Eleanor's house. The director pulls the folders for the month and reviews them before taking copies for him and the accompanist, then gives the folders to Jo to make up singer's packets. She also The director files them after we're done with them.

There may be work to do on any particular folder. It will be up to the director to make sure the word sheets match the music, the sheets are legible, and there are words and music sheets suitable for the chorus. The director will arrange for making copies so there are enough for the chorus. Jo has the job of collating and "uncollating" the music for the chorus notebooks.

Each folder for individual songs has the original piano music at the bottom of the pile, marked with a pink or orange dot, and under a paper clip. These are important archive copies. Director or accompanist may remove any chorus copies from the folders as needed. Do not use copies under the paper clip with pink or orange dots, as they are archive copies. (unless there are multiple copies). Copy them as needed, and someone should check the folders before filing to make sure the archive copies are all there. That will allow the pianist to use the music again, as needed.

Transposed songs are marked with a "+" in this list. A green dot on the archive copy means that the song has been transposed, and the key can easily be changed. Contact Marilyn if that needs to be done as she has the computer files for this. Joanie should have the opportunity to choose what music (particularly if it has been transposed) she wants from each folder.

The dates of last performance have been removed from this list due to the coronavirus interruption. You may decide they are not necessary in the future.

A few songs have been marked "No word sheets" on this list. That means there are no copies of the words for the chorus in the folder. These songs were done before we provided word sheets, and someone will need to type the lyrics or print them from the internet. If the internet lyrics are used, the words need to be checked with the music to be sure everyone has the same lyrics.

This document also includes songs in our Patriotic, Religious, Irish, and Christmas collections. These are in different areas of the filing cabinets as labeled.

All categories have lists of potential new songs and old solos. The main list is particularly long. There are only one or a few copies of these songs, not a full folder. They can be transformed into a chorus song by making a new folder with words sheets and music sheets for singers, or just copied for special performances. The music for these potential new songs is currently at Marilyn's house, in an alphabetized group of folders.

At the end of this document is a short list of suggested ethnic songs for the month of March, and a list of Spanish music that has been collected.

The director is responsible for producing a performance list for chorus members when it's his month. Copies of each performance list need to be given to each member, and an archive copy added to the notebook "Chorus Music History". George has this notebook and has been doing this. That book is a treasure trove of chorus history; years of great lists already compiled.

The chorus has accumulated an extensive library of music books from the 1900's through the 1950's. There is an Excel database of all the songs in these books on the website, which can be searched to find a particular song. All of these books are currently located at Marilyn's house. They are up for adoption if anyone is interested in housing them. They should probably stay together as long as the chorus is active, however.
